Transfer of Wealth: What Does it Mean for Our Community?



A 2012 study conducted by Wichita State University for Kansas Association of Community Foundations, including the Smoky Hills Charitable Foundation, brings the importance of estate planning to the forefront for Kansas.

The research results project that by 2020, more than \$79 billion of wealth will transfer from one generation to the next in the state of Kansas. Looking at a 50 year time frame, the wealth transfer is estimated at \$1.2 billion in Ellsworth County.

If we capture a portion of this wealth, even 5%, by setting up endowments through SHCF we could provide a permanent source of funding for local organizations and causes that will greatly improve lives in Smoky Hills communities.

What can you do?

- 1) Designate SHCF or your favorite charity to receive 5% of your final estate through your will or trust.
- 2) Start the conversation with your neighbors and friends.
